Kevin W. Cutter, Jr., 19 of East Greenbush was arrested by Officer Nicholas Peter, after police were called to investigate the stalking complaint of a 19 year old former acquaintance. The acquaintance is protected by a court order of protection, which was violated when Cutter confronted her in the Price Chopper parking lot. As she attempted to flee in her car, Cutter smashed the driver side window in an attempt to get her. A passer-by restrained Cutter until police arrived. Cutter was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engel on charges of Criminal Contempt, Criminal Mischief/Damage to Property and Stalking 4th Dgr. and was remanded to County Jail.

In other cases;

Police responded to the vicinity of Ridge Road to investigate a report of someone shooting a rifle from a 2nd floor window. Officers located a victim who pointed out a nearby residence, where someone had discharged a long gun from an upstairs room. The victim's parked car had been damaged from pellet-shot. Officer Matthew Wyld located the shooter, James A. Wheelings, 33, who lives on the second floor of the residence nearby. He claimed to have been target shooting from the window. He was arraigned before Town Justice Mary Pat Donnelly on charges of Reckless Endangerment 2nd Dgr. and Criminal Mischief/Damage to Property 4th Dgr. Bail was set at \$1500.00.
