Alexea C. Paschall, 35 of Albany, was detained by Colonie Police at the scene of a domestic dispute, when it became known that she was wanted on a Town Court Bench Warrant. Paschall had failed to comply with court orders concerning her Larceny case that was pending in Town Court. She was booked and turned over to court by Officer Griffin Hotaling.

In other cases;

Jonathan A. Rivera, 20 of Rensselaer was detained by Rensselaer City Police on a Town Court Bench Warrant, after he failed to appear in the Town Courtroom as directed, to answer a charge of stealing that had been brought against him. He was booked at police headquarters by Officer Griffin Hotaling and turned over to court.

Tara Lee Seney, 28 of Castleton was detained by Columbia County Sheriff's Deputies on a Town Court Bench Warrant. Seney had been ordered to appear before Town Justice Kevin Engle on a Larceny charge, but failed to do so. She was booked at police headquarters by Officer Griffin Hotaling and released pending further court proceedings.

Nekie J. Ricks, 24 of Albany was tracked down at his employment in town and arrested by Officer Michael Herrington. Ricks was wanted in connection with an assault that occurred in the City of Albany, and a warrant of arrest had been issued for his arrest.

Anthony J. Wilkinson, Jr., 35 of East Greenbush was taken into custody by Detective Michael Guadagnino, after police were alerted that a warrant had been issued by Family Court. Wilkinson was then brought before a Family Court Magistrate by Sheriff's Deputies.

Robert E. Burns, 37 of Albany was taken into custody by Officer Griffin Hotaling on a Bench Warant . Burns had failed to appear in court after being charged with Forgery.
