Justin A. Jackson, 24 of West Sand Lake was charged by Officer Matthew Wyld with Physical Contact Harassment. In the complaint, an acquaintance reported that she was driving and behind the wheel with Jackson in the front passenger seat. He became enraged that she would not allow him to read her text messages and in a fit of anger he slugged her across the face. Jackson was brought before Town Justice Kevin Engel for arraignment and who issued an Order of Protection. Jackson was then turned over to Thruway State Police who held a Bench Warrant for his arrest for failure to appear on a DWI charge.

In other cases;

While investigating a personal injury traffic accident, Officer Griffin Hotaling charged Jose Luis Roman, 39 of Niverville with DWI. The 1:30 a.m. incident occurred on I-90.

Brandi L. Ashley, 31 of Rensselaer was arrested by city police and turned over to Officer Edward Witko on a bench warrant. Town Justice Mary Pat Donnelly had issued the warrant after Ashley failed to attend court proceedings that had been scheduled to hear a Larceny case against her.

Officer Michael Herrington charged Donald K. Johnson, 38 of Nassau with Harassment for sending several digital messages to another person that contained insulting and disrespectful language.

During a traffic investigation at about 3:00 a.m., Officer Griffin Hotaling ticketed Shannon E. Stickel with Driving While Suspended and Unlawful Possession of Marijuana.

While conducting traffic enforcement in the Sherwood Park neighborhood, Officer Donald Deitz ticketed Matthew C. Goldup, 26, for driving at night with no headlights. Based on the strong odor of burnt marijuana, a quantity of weed was located and seized.
