Kyle R. VanAuken, 25 of Wynantskill was stopped at about midnight, after he was seen driving through a red traffic signal on Third Avenue Extension at Troy Road and nearly causing a collision. After failing a set of field sobriety tests, he was charged by Officer Griffin Hotaling with Driving While Impaired by Drugs, Driving While Suspended, Possession of Cocaine residue and Possession of Marijuana.

In other cases;

Stanley L. Ball, 60 of Troy was tracked down at his job and arrested by Officer Griffin Hotaling on a warrant. Ball had been originally charged with stealing and was free pending a court hearing but then never showed up for it. The warrant was then issued.

Joel F. Morales, 23 of Springfield Mass. turned himself in to Officer Michael Guadagnino, on a Bench Warrant for failing to appear for a hearing into his DWI arrest on March 2nd.

Rosemily Rivera, 25 of Albany answered the Warrant Officer's notification to report to police headquarters on an Arrest Warrant. She had originally been charged with stealing on February 23rd but never appeared in court when scheduled.

Christopher M. Spath, 18 and Andrew T. Spath, 21, both of Rensselaer, were ticketed by Officer Peter Lavin, when it was determined that they were consuming marijuana vapors while driving.

Derek M. Shellogg, 21 of Catskill was charged at about 4:00 a.m. with DWI and other infractions after his pick truck up was clocked speeding and seen weaving on the highway. He was ticketed by Officer Mark Herrington.
