Nicholas B. Webb, 35 of Rensselaer was taken into custody while being a passenger in a car that had been stopped for a traffic matter. A Bench Warrant had been issued after he never showed up in court for his arrest last month on DWI. He was booked at police headquarters by Officer Edward Witko.

In other cases;

Karen A. Herrick, 56, was arrested where she has recently taken up residence in Hampton Manor. Herrick was found in close proximity to suspected drug activity and was taken into custody by Detective Michael Guadagnino on a warrant issued by Albany City Court. She was turned over to Albany Police.
