Donald F. Thomas, 61 of New Paltz, was stopped while driving on Troy Road after Officer Nicholas Peter noticed his Jeep was making improper lane changes. During questioning, alcohol impairment was determined. Thomas was charged with DWI and Endangerment, due to a passenger being a minor.

In other DWI cases;

Danielle R. Harbeck, 34 of East Greenbush was charged after being stopped at about 1:45 a.m. Officer Edward Witko had noticed erratic vehicle movements and conducted the traffic stop to investigate.

Gregg R. Lammon, 50 of Troy was charged at about 3:30 a.m. after his 2002 Jeep was clocked at 60 MPH in a 35 MPH zone on Columbia Turnpike. Lammon failed standard field sobriety tests that were administered by Officers Edward Ashley and Michael Guadagnino.

Crystal L. McDonagh, 44 of East Greenbush was stopped at about 1:30 a.m. after Officer Edward Ashley noticed her car drifting repeatedly over the white fog line as she travelled on Red Mill Road. She was charged after field testing determined alcohol impairment.

Danny L. Dixon, 32 of Albany was charged with about 11:00 p.m. after Officer Michael Herrington observed him drive out of a motel parking lot and into the path of oncoming traffic on Columbia Turnpike. During the traffic stop for failure to yield the right-of-way, Mr. Dixon was unable to pass a set of sobriety tests and was charged with DWI.

Joshua M. Newman, 28 of East Greenbush was clocked speeding on Columbia Turnpike and stopped for investigation by Officer Matthew Wyld. After a set of field sobriety tests were administered, the motorist was ticketed for DWI and speeding.
