Mark E. Pullen, 56 of Albany was charged by Sgt. He was also charged with Driving an Unregistered Motor Vehicle, Uninsured Vehicle and Driving Without a License. He was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engel and remanded to the County Jail.

In other cases;

Bhakti M. Thakkar, 31 from New Jersey was noticed placing merchandise into her coat pockets and then leaving Hannaford Supermarket without paying for it. Loss Prevention Officers detained her and recovered over \$60 dollars worth of stolen Revlon and Maybelline cosmetic products. She was arrested and charged with Larceny by Officer Donald Deitz.

Algeta A. Rozier, 41 and Dejanique Z. Rozier 19, of Troy were charged with Larceny by Officer Michael Herrington after they acted together to take \$650.00 worth of cosmetics, fragrances and jewelry merchandise from the Target sales floor and leave without paying.

Jessica J. Leahey, 32 of East Greenbush was charged at about 3:00 a.m. after she arrived at her mother's home and awakened her with loud and threatening language and behavior. When neighbors called police to report a fight, Officer Edward Witko responded and took Leahey into custody. She was charged with Physical Contact Harassment, Evidence Tampering and Possession of Marijuana. Town Justice Kevin Engel remanded her to County Jail.
