In other cases;

Kira Shaquel Young, 34 of Albany was arrested for taking \$35 dollars worth of food and cosmetic merchandise and leaving Walmart without paying. She was charged with Larceny by Officer Matthew Wyld.

Ramear S. Burns, 40 of Albany was arrested by Sgt. Ernest Tubbs, following the investigation into a \$900.00 TV heist from Walmart. He was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engle on charges of Larceny and Conspiracy and was assigned to Probation Day Reporting pending further court proceedings.

Christopher P. Gongoeski, 19 of Cohoes and Jasmyne A. Rose, 19 of East Greenbush were charged after police were called by residents of the Yorkshire Drive neighborhood who reported drug activity afoot. Officer Nicholas Peter investigated and stopped the vehicle that was pointed out by neighbors. Methadone hydrochloride, cocaine and marijuana were seized from Ms. Rose who was charged with two counts of Criminal Possession Controlled Substance 7th Dgr. and Unlawful Possession of Marijuana. Mr. Gongoeski was charged with Driving Without a License.
