Police recovered BB guns, CO2 cartridges for the BB guns, fidget spinners and other merchandise. They were released to parents and will appear in Family Court.

In other cases;

Kristopher J. Skarzynski, 19 of East Greenbush was taken into custody by State Police during a traffic stop, when it was learned he was wanted by Town Court for failure to appear in court on Larceny charges. He was booked by Officer Trevor LaGrave.
