Around 5:00 a.m., neighbors called police to complain that a red BMW kept accelerating up and down their street and that the loud laughter of young persons had become a nuisance. Officer Edward Ashley located the vehicle and subsequently charged Dalton S. MacDonald, 19 of East Greenbush with DWI , Unlawful Possession of Alcohol, Open Container among other counts.

In other cases;

Jaquan T. Tolbert, 26 of Albany was brought in by state prison guards on a Town Court Bench Warrant. Tolbert had been arrested for DWI in March but then disappeared, only to be later arrested on unrelated charges and sent to state prison.

John P. Tisko, 35 of Troy was stopped for traffic violations and then taken into custody by Detective Michael Guadagnino after investigation revealed that Tisko's license was suspended due to a total of 24 scofflaw orders that have been placed against him by local traffic courts throughout the state.

Brittney E. Kline, 25 of Albany answered the appearance notice sent by Warrant Control Dispatcher Ronald Yeates after Kline missed her court date for Driving Without a License. She was escorted to the courtroom by Detective Michael Guadagnino.

Ben W. Baker, 31 of East Greenbush answered his appearance notice sent by Warrant Control after he failed to show up in court as scheduled to answer charges of Criminal Mischief-Damage to Property. He was brought before Judge Mary Pat Donnelly by Officer Matthew Wyld.

Donna J. Credidio, 56 of Cohoes appeared at police headquarters per notification by Warrant Control, to answer a Town Court Bench Warrant that was issued when Credidio failed to carry out the court's orders regarding a Larceny case. She was brought before Judge Mary Pat Donnelly by Officer Trevor LaGrave.
