Based on the investigation of Officer Mark Herrington and Detective Michael Guadagnino, a Troy man has been charged with Forgery. Clyde N. Bowles, Jr., 25 of Troy was arrested following the probe into theft and forgery of personal checks. While employed as an auto mechanic in town, Bowles is accused of stealing blank checks from a customer's car and forging one of them for \$500 dollars. He was arraigned in Town Court by Judge Kevin Engel and remanded to County Jail.

In other cases;

Curtiss B. Mitchell, 19 and Deshawn R. Pearson, 21, both of Troy, were arrested for Larceny after they left Walmart pushing a cartful of merchandise they never stopped to pay for. The two had selected 46 grocery and general merchandise items including pots and pans, a 13 piece matching designer bathroom rug and towel set, household cleaner, laundry soap and other domestic supplies worth over \$250 dollars. They were spotted by store employees leaving the parking lot in a silver Nissan with Pennsylvania plates and got as far as Troy Road at Route 43 before being pulled over and taken into custody by Officer Raymond Diaz and Officer Michael Herrington.

Linda J. Morgan, 57 of Averill Park is facing Larceny charges for her part in a scheme to defraud Walmart of \$250 dollars through false substitution of customer-purchased gift cards. She was arrested by Officer Mark Herrington who responded to investigate.
