Kevin W. Cutter, Jr., 19 of East Greenbush, Felicia L. Leach, 17 of Nassau and Kaitlyn M. Poplaski, 17 of Pittsfield were observed shopping together at Target. However, their selection of merchandise from the shelves was being placed into a large handbag being carried around, rather than a shopping cart. They chose twenty products ranging from cosmetics to snack food before deciding to leave the store without stopping at check outs to pay. Each was arrested and charged with larceny by Officer Nicholas Peter.

In other cases:

After removing a pair of new boots from their merchandise box in the shoe department at Walmart, Richard F. Agley then proceeded to put them on and began walking around the store. He went to the electronics section where he picked up a wireless router and then proceeded to the customer service desk and stated that he wanted a refund, claiming to have bought the router but lost the receipt. At that point he was taken into custody and charged with stealing both articles. He was booked at police headquarters by Officer Matthew Wyld and turned over to Troy Police who held an active warrant for his arrest.
